Step1. Set prices for cabinet

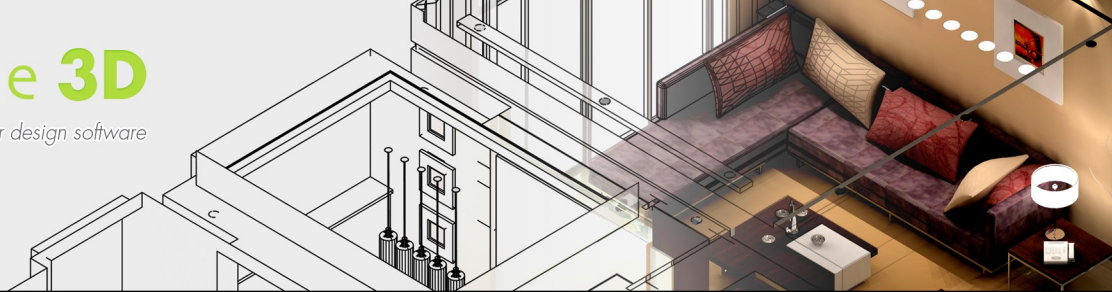
If your cabinets are measured by piece, select *by piece*, else select *by length*, and next...

Base Unit (500-600D, 680-720H) is the title.

This means: **Base Unit (500-600D, 680-720H)** stands for cabinets depth form 500 to 600 and height form 680 to 720 from

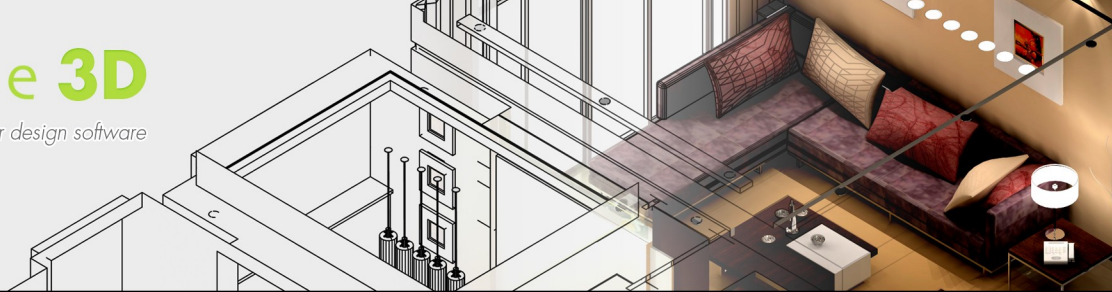
Price grade of doors

This means: for cabinets from 500 to 600 depth and form 680 to 720 height, when using doors of grade B, the price is 2000/m



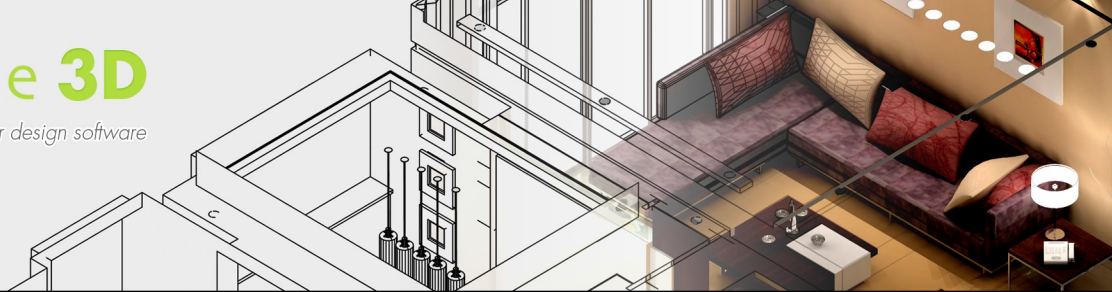
